

**The DEADLINE for entering images for this Season's IMAGE OR THE YEAR COMPETITION
is midnight on TUESDAY 18th MAY 2021**

The Image of the Year Competition will be held on Tuesday 25th May 2021 via ZOOM. Again, due to the covid pandemic prints will NOT be included and there only be an award for the best digital image.

The judge for this Season's competition will be Jonathan Vaines AFIAP CPAGB LRPS who will in the first part of the evening whittle down the entries to approximate 20 images that will compete after the break for the honour of being selected 'Image of the Year'.

ALL members of the Society are allowed to enter ONE (1) image of their choice in the competition. This is an OPEN competition and images from all genres of photography are permitted either in monochrome or colour.

The only constraints are as follows:

- 1) Images that have been accepted for a previous NDPS Annual Exhibition held at Norwich Cathedral or entered in a previous Image of the Year competition are not eligible.
- 2) All elements of a submitted image must originate from a photographic image captured with a camera and subsequently post-processed solely by the member submitting the image.
- 3) A re-worked image that was previously entered in POTY (for example to take on board feedback from the judge) it is a NEW IMAGE, and the original image WILL NO LONGER qualify for IOTY as an automatic entry (see below).
- 4) In addition, the normal competition rules regarding copyright also apply.

Besides, the ONE (1) image every member is allowed to enter (as detailed above) images that scored 9.5 or higher in each of the five qualifying rounds of this Season's POTY competition would also normally automatically qualify to be included in IOTY. At the end of this memo is a list of the SIXTY-NINE (69) eligible images that qualify for automatic entry in IOTY.

Because of the extra-ordinary number of images that scored such a high score in POTY it has therefore been necessary to limit all members to a MAXIMUM of THREE (3) entries in this Season's IOTY.

All those members who have three or more images in the list below will already have received an email asking them to select those images they want to be entered in IOTY.

If a member has two or less images in the list below these images will all entered in IOTY.

There is no need for members to re-submit images that automatically qualified via POTY. However, as stated above a re-worked image will replace their original image and become the ONE (1) new image all members are allowed to enter.

New images must be entered via the website using the 'OTHER COMPETITIONS' option.

Images should be as normal 1,600 x 1,200 pixels (maximum) in sRGB colour space
